
Dog Waste Pollutes Our Shediac Bay!

Dog waste left on our pavement, grass or beach does not just go away or fertilize the lawn. The bacteria in dog waste is often washed down our storm drains and into the bay, and can travel for miles in the water.



The bacteria in dog waste can make it unsafe to harvest shellfish or swim in our water.

A day's waste from one large dog can contain 7.8 billion fecal coliform bacteria, enough to close 15 acres of shell-fish beds!
