2016 Census – Release 4 Income September 13, 2017



Almost 30,000 children in the province living in low-income households

This article focuses on persons who were younger than 18 at the time of the 2016 Census and living in low-income households. It uses the low-income measure, after tax (LIM-AT) to classify persons by income status.

- There were approximately 124,000 New Brunswickers living in a low-income household in 2015. Just under 30,000 (23.6%) of these low-income persons were children younger than 18 years of age.
- While children made up a smaller proportion of the low-income population, the incidence of living in a low-income household was higher for them than it was for adults. In 2015, 22.2% of children younger than 18 in the province lived in a low-income household compared to 16.0% of adults aged 18 and older.
- Younger children were more likely to experience low income than older children. One in four (25.1%) children younger than 6 lived in a low-income household compared to nearly one in five (19.4%) children aged 11 to 17. In addition, 22.9% of children aged 6 to 10 lived in a low-income household.
- Among the urban centres, Campbellton had the highest rate of children younger than 18 living in low-income households (27.8%) and Moncton had the lowest (20.3%).
