

Mobility status 1 year ago

<u>Mobility status 1 year ago</u> refers to the status of a person with regard to the place of residence on the reference day (May 10, 2016) in relation to the place of residence on the same date one year earlier.

Persons can be **non-movers** (lived at the same address 1 year earlier) or **movers**. **Movers** include **non-migrants** (lived at a different address in the same census subdivision 1 year earlier) and **migrants**. **Migrants** include **external migrants** (lived outside Canada 1 year earlier) and **internal migrants**. **Internal migrants** include **interprovincial migrants** (lived in a different province or territory 1 year earlier) and **intraprovincial migrants** (lived in a different census subdivision in the province 1 year earlier). See <u>Figure 6.2</u> of the 2016 Census Dictionary.

- According to the 2016 Census, almost 9 out of 10 New Brunswickers aged 1 year and over (88.6%) lived in the same residence in 2016 as they did in 2015.
- A further 9.3% reported they had moved within the province between 2015 and 2016, while 1.5% indicated they had moved to New Brunswick from a different province or territory.
- A small proportion of the provincial population (0.6%) indicated they had lived outside the country one year earlier.
