WEEKLY NEW BRUNSWICK INFLUENZA REPORT

Reporting period: August 30 – September 5, 2009 (week 35)

Week 35 marks the start of the 2009-2010 Influenza Season

1. Reports of influenza-like illness (ILI) from Flu Watch sentinel physicians in New Brunswick:

(9 physicians recruited so far this year (2008/2009) report the number of patients with ILI symptoms over total number of patients seen on one day each week):

4 physicians reported a total of 1 case of ILI of the 85 patients seen for any reason during this reporting period

This week, the ILI consultation rate was 11.8 consultations per 1,000 patient visits which is a decrease from last week. The sentinel response rate was 44%.

New Brunswick Influenza Virus Surveillance Program (specimens are submitted by recruited sentinel physicians, Emergency Rooms, nursing homes and some community physicians). All laboratory specimens are tested using a real-time PCR assay, which is a rapid detection method designed for detection of all known variants of influenza A and B. All laboratory-confirmed cases are reported for the week when laboratory confirmation was received.

Graph 1: Number and percent of positive influenza specimens in New Brunswick (based on data from Dumont Laboratory), by week, as of September 5, 2009


