#### **PURPOSE**

To establish procedural standards for administration in the event of a clients arrest by an employee for offences against federal or provincial statutes.

# **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Chapter C-26 s.27 Corrections Act of New Brunswick.

#### **SCOPE**

This policy applies to all employees of the Adult Custody Services division of the Department of Justice and Public Safety.

#### **POLICY GUIDELINES**

In the event of an arrest by an employee of the institution, the Superintendent or designate shall be notified.

### **PROCEDURE**

# **Notify Law Enforcement**

The Superintendent or designate after being advised that an arrest has been made, shall subsequently notify the appropriate law enforcement agency.

# **Incident Reports**

All staff involved are to prepare detailed reports, which are to be submitted to the Sergeant prior to the end of the shift.

# **Notify Director**

The Superintendent shall, as soon as possible, notify the Director of Adult Custody Services whenever such actions outlined above are initiated.

# **Notify Assistant Deputy Minister**

The Director of Adult Custody Services shall, upon learning of any incident outlined in this section, advise the Assistant Deputy Minister immediately.
