MISSION STATEMENT

PURPOSE

To outline procedural guidelines surrounding firearms in Adult Custody facilities.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

NB Corrections Act.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all employees of the Adult Custody Services division of the Department of Justice and Public Safety.

POLICY GUIDELINES

Firearms are <u>not</u> to be retained in any Provincial Adult Custody facility except for the temporary storage of firearms for visiting police officers.

PROCEDURE

Storage

All firearms temporarily secured for visiting Law Enforcement and Sherriff services personnel are to have the cartridges removed prior to storage.

Staff prohibited

Staff members are prohibited from carrying or having in their possession any firearm, or object which may be considered an offensive weapon, while in or around the institution, or having such an item within a privately-owned vehicle parked on institutional property.
