#### **MISSION STATEMENT**

Adult Custody Services is committed to providing professional practices that respect human rights and ensure safety for all. #### **PURPOSE**

To establish a standardized routine for conducting an inspection of facilities to maintain safety and security.

#### LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

#### Corrections Act NB Regulation 35(a)

#### **SCOPE**

This policy applies to all employees of the Adult Custody Services division of the Department of Justice and Public Safety.

#### **POLICY GUIDELINES**

Director of Adult custody Services will visit each institution regularly.

#### **PROCEDURE**

#### **Annual Inspection**

Superintendent shall arrange annual visits from the:

- Provincial Fire Marshal's office
- Health Inspector
- Representative of Supply and Services

#### **Superintendent Inspection**

The Superintendent shall conduct inspection tours of the facility regularly.

#### Sergeant's Inspection

Sergeant (or designated authority) shall conduct inspection of the facility and grounds on each shift and complete an inspection report to the Superintendent outlining any areas of concern.
