Chapter – 26 Corrections Act of New Brunswick

SCOPE

This policy applies to all employees of the Adult Custody Services division of the Department of Justice and Public Safety.

POLICY GUIDELINES

Clients are required to wear issued clothing. Local Policy will describe the issuance of clothing.

PROCEDURE

Issued clothing

Clients will be provided with clothing suitable for:

- the climate.
- their work assignment; and
- maintenance of good health.
