MISSION STATEMENT

PURPOSE

To establish procedural standards for the inter-institutional transfer of clients.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Section 13 New Brunswick Corrections Act

Section 16 New Brunswick Corrections Act R.S.N.B. 1973, c. C-26 (Provincial Hospital)

Section 743(5) Criminal Code of Canada. (Provincial to Federal Penitentiary)

SCOPE

This policy applies to all employees of the Adult Custody Services division of the Department of Justice and Public Safety.

POLICY GUIDELINES

The Director of Adult Custody Services is responsible to ensure that adult clients are housed appropriately and that transfers are carried out as required. Approval for transfer decisions may be delegated to:

- Superintendents,
- Deputy Superintendents and
- Chief Superintendent of Operations

PROCEDURE

All inter-institutional transfers requiring the exchange of clients from one vehicle to another shall be **only** be completed on RCMP or Municipal Police property.
