

What is the AIP?

The Atlantic Immigration Program (AIP) is an employer-driven program intended for New Brunswick employers to hire skilled foreign workers and international graduates from recognized post-secondary institutions in Atlantic Canada who want to work and live in New Brunswick.

Become a Designated Employer

Employers facing labour shortages must become designated to have their positions endorsed by the province and to hire candidates under the AIP. This can be completed through the **INB portal**. Here is how to become a designated employer:

- 1. Create an Immigration NB (INB) employer profile or log into your existing profile.
- 2. Submit an Expression of Interest (EOI), including information about your company and labour needs.
- 3. You will receive an Invitation to Apply if your EOI details align with the AIP criteria (sector, NOCs and salary).
- 4. Apply for designation and complete **required training** (Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada onboarding and intercultural competency).

Requirements for Designation

- Business is operating in good standing.
- · Information on labour needs provided.
- Full-time permanent and non-seasonal job offers available.
- Commitment to work with a service provider organization on settlement and retention.

Endorsing Candidates

Employers with an AIP designation are ready to endorse a candidate. Your candidate:

- will be eligible for an employer-specific work permit.
- must meet all program requirements for language, education, and work experience.
